How the Program Works:

1. The program welcomes children of all abilities and is recommended for PreK – 5th graders.
2. You may register your child for the reading programs starting June 1, 2017 at the library.
3. Last day for registration, to qualify for raffle prizes and the end of program grab bag is June 30th.
4. Each child will receive a log book to record the titles of books read this summer and a calendar to keep track of library visits.
5. For every five books your child reads, he/she will receive one raffle ticket and a "ribbon" to be hung at the library.
6. For each visit to the library your child will get his/her calendar stamped and receive a raffle ticket (limit of one per day).
At the end of each Thursday program, we'll draw tickets for prizes.
7. At the last program, each registered child receives a grab bag. Last day for bag pick up is August 31, 2017.

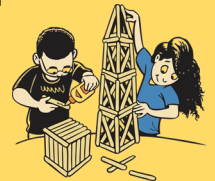
