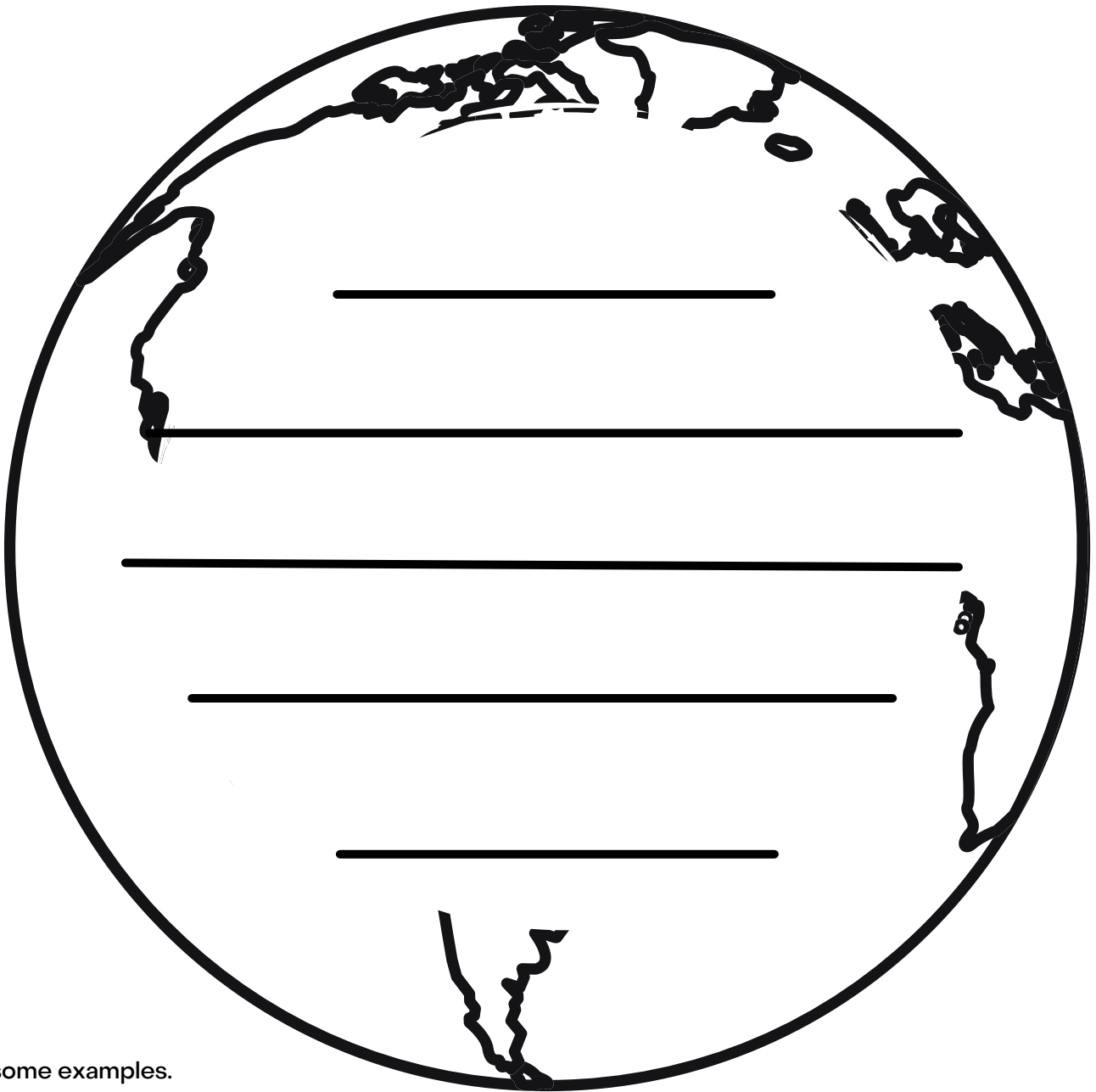


Sherman & Ruth Weiss Community Library
