- Summer Reading is for babies/toddlers, children, teens, and adults!
- Do it on your own or with your family. Even daycare services can register as a group.
- You may read fiction, non-fiction, picture books, chapter books, comics, graphic novels, easy readers, articles, and poetry. (Sorry, social media posts don't count.) You may read on paper or online. You can listen to audiobooks, too!
- Besides reading, you can earn Activity Badges when you go outside and interact with nature or participate in library programs.



Returning this summer - Beanstack!

- It's a free, easy-to-use app accessible via any Apple or Android hand-held device or your desktop.
- Sign up and log your Summer Reading minutes on our Beanstack site: <https://weisscommunitylibrary.beanstack.org/reader365>
- Virtual tracking replaces the paper reading records and offers reward badges.

Paper Log

- You can also do the challenges and activities through Beanstack by completing the paper log found on our website at <https://www.weisscommunitylibrary.com>, by calling 715-634-2161 so we can mail a copy to you, or you can pick up a copy at the library.
- You can return your completed paper log to us by stopping at the front desk, placing it in our dropbox, or mailing it, and we can enter the data for you so you will qualify for prizes.
- If you are using the website or app, you can still use the paper log to track reading minutes and completed activities to record online at a later time.

Prizes

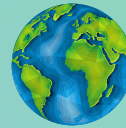

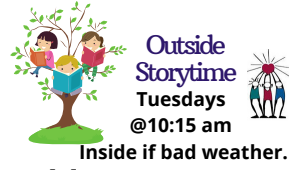
